Revive Us Again

Charles Finney (8/29/1792-8/16/1875), one of America's ardent evangelists in the 19th century, recognized the necessity and power in prayer. Highly educated and respected in his community, he was dedicated to the profession of law until he met Jesus Christ. Then "I had no longer any desire to practice law ... no labor, I thought, could be so sweet, and no employment so exalted, as that of holding up Christ."

Actually, my interest in this great man of God began during my undergraduate years studying at Berea College (KY). When John G. Fee established Berea in 1855, it was for all persons regardless of race or gender. Oberlin College in Ohio was a model for Berea. Oberlin was the first American college to accept women and blacks as students in addition to white men. From its early years, its faculty and students were active in the abolitionist movement. They participated together with people of the town in biracial efforts to help fugitive slaves on the Underground Railroad, as well as to resist the Fugitive Slave Act. Many slaves escaped to Ohio across the Ohio River from Kentucky, making the state a critical point for their passage to freedom. Many know the history of Berea College and its commitment to serve students from 240 Appalachian counties. Perhaps I will talk more about Berea College, but want to introduce you to Charles Finney, known as the Father of Modern Revivalism.

In 1835, the wealthy silk merchant and benefactor Arthur Tappan (1786-1865) offered financial backing to the newly founded Oberlin Collegiate Institute (as Oberlin College was known before 1850), and he invited Finney, on the recommendation of abolitionist Theodore Dwight Weld (1803-95), to establish its theological department. After much wrangling, Finney accepted, on

the conditions that he be allowed to continue to preach in New York, that the school admit blacks, and that free speech be guaranteed at Oberlin. After more than a decade, he was selected as its second president, serving from 1851 to 1866. (He had already served as acting President in 1849.) Incidentally, the chairman of my doctoral committee at the University of Kentucky, Dr. Richard **Miller**, became the Oberlin president. Dr. Paul Street, renowned director of the University of Kentucky Press, replaced him on the committee and ably guided me through the doctoral program completed in 1970.


To most people the name Charles Finney is not immediately associated with outstanding American evangelists such as Billy Sunday or Dwight L. Moody. Yet Finney's messages influenced thousands in the mid-19th century America, and as a result he has become known as one of our nation's most prolific evangelists.

During his ministry, one of Finney's most significant emphases dealt with the necessity of prayer as it related to spiritual revival. Spiritual revival in our country is the heart cry of many evangelical Christians at this time in American history.

In accepting the nomination of his party as the candidate for President, Joe Biden proclaimed that the soul of America is at stake in the 2020 presidential election. When the vice presidential candidate was announced, she said that we must fight for our values.

Whether they intended to do so or not, both spoke the truth. However, their platform is 180 degrees different than the views

of Conservative Christians. Don't be deceived. We need a spiritual awakening that will bring America back to the foundation laid by our founding fathers. According to Finney, prayer is the primary catalyst to any revival of God's Spirit. The history of past revivals substantiates Finney's claim.



In my book, Intercession: Prayer as Work, I have a rather complete history of spiritual awakenings in America and in the world. In this issue of the Reflector, I want to share the great spiritual awakening of 1857-1858 and the one that followed in the early 1900's. I want to go to Charles Finney's book, Lectures on Revivals and share his ten essential characteristics of prevailing prayer.

Great Spiritual Awakening 1857–1858, Early 1900's

The great spiritual awakening of 1857-58 had its beginnings in New York City with a six-man prayer meeting initiated by layman **Jeremiah Lamphier**. Within eight months it was conservatively estimated that 10,000 businessmen were meeting daily for prayer in New York City.

The contagious spirit of intercessory prayer and spiritual renewal in New York also affected Philadelphia. By March, 1858, it

was reported that churches in the downtown area were so crowded with people praying that large secular auditoriums were made available to accommodate the multitudes who also desired to pray.

Soon hundreds of thousands of people in Boston, Washington D.C., and Chicago turned to prayer, and the land was electric with the power of the Holy Spirit. The movement spread up the Hudson River Valley, across the Alleghenies and across the land. According to Dr. J. Edwin Orr, leading authority on revival, all subsequent movements were measured against this outstanding event because it was such a remarkable turning of a whole nation toward God. Do it again, Lord, in the third decade of the 21st Century is our **heart's cry**. Remember, God is able! God is willing! God is waiting for us to call upon Him.

In the early 1900's, Americans again experienced a national spiritual awakening. Originating in Philadelphia, revival spread through the New England states and then to the South. In Atlanta, Georgia, newspapers reported that nearly 1,000 businessmen were uniting in prayer. About that same time, according to Dr. Orr, it was recorded that stores, factories and offices in Atlanta closed in the middle of the day for prayer. The Supreme Court of Georgia adjourned; even saloons and places of amusement closed their doors to enable patrons to attend the united prayer meetings.

In Louisville, Kentucky, the press reported fifty-eight of the leading business firms in the city closed at noon for prayer meetings and that conversions were numbering 4,000.

The awakening moved from the South to the Northwest, then to the West, and by the end of 1905, revival engulfed the United States and then across the world. This revival, typical of those in America's past, was characterized by prayer, ardent evangelism and concern for those who did not know Christ. Do it again, Lord, in the third decade of the 21st Century is our cry. Remember, God is able! God is willing! God is waiting for us to call upon Him.

On the basis of history, it is evident that prayer is a significant part of spiritual revival. As Finney wrote almost 200 years ago, There are **two kinds of means** requisite to promote a revival: the one to influence men, the other to influence God. The <u>truth</u> is employed to influence men, and <u>prayer</u> to move God.

Essential Characteristics of Prevailing Prayer

According to Charles Finney, prayer that moves God is called prevailing or effectual prayer. In his book, Lectures on Revivals, Charles Finney, describes the essential characteristics of prevailing prayer.


- Pray for a definite object.
 A man must have some definite object before his mind. He cannot pray effectually for a variety of objects at once. All the instances of effectual prayer recorded in the Bible were of this kind.
- Pray in accordance with the revealed will of God. There are three ways in which God's will is revealed to men for their guidance in prayer: (1) By

express promises or predictions in the Bible, that He will give or do certain things. (2) Sometimes God reveals His will by Providence (3) Sometimes by His Spirit. When God's people are at a loss what to pray for, agreeable to His will, His Spirit often instructs them.

- 3. Pray with submission to the will of God. What I mean by submission in prayer is acquiescence to the revealed will of God.
- 4. Prayer must be offered from right motives. Prayer should not be selfish, but dictated by a supreme regard for the glory of God.
- 5. Prayer must be by the intercession of the Spirit.

 You can never expect to offer prayer according to the Spirit.
- 6. If you mean to pray effectually, it must be persevering prayer. Prayer is not effectual unless it is offered with intense desire for the blessing and offered up with great agony of desire (Psalms 119:53: 'Burning indignation has seized me because of the wicked, who forsake Thy law').
- 7. If you mean to pray effectually, you must pray a great deal. It was said of the apostle James, that after he was dead it was found his knees were calloused like a camel's knees by praying so much...
- 8. If you intend prayer to be effectual, it must be offered in the name of Christ.

 You cannot come to God in your own name. But you can come in a name that is always acceptable. If you should go to the bank with

a draft or note, endorsed by **John Jacob Astor**, that would be giving you his name, and you know you could get the money from the bank just as well as he could himself. Now Jesus Christ gives you the use of His name..

9. You cannot prevail in prayer without renouncing all sins.

10. You must pray in faith. . You must expect to obtain the things you ask for. You need not look for an answer to prayer, if you pray without any expectation of obtaining it.

The reference to John Jacob Astor dates Finney's previous illustration, but the truths he sets forth are relevant and essential to effectual prayer today. At some point, I plan to share the prayer movement led by Armin Gesswein that empowered the Los Angeles Crusade that launched Billy Graham's amazing evangelistic ministry in the 20th Century.

Duties of a Christian Citizen



As we contemplate our forthcoming national election on Tuesday, November 3rd, we as Christians are faced with the greatest challenge and opportunity in the history of our country. The stakes are high because the lines have been drawn, seemingly set in concrete, for the soul of our nation. All that we hold dear in terms of faith and freedom are in grave jeopardy.

Over the years I have approached the issue urging believers to push against the spiritual darkness through prayer. It is said that in the last national election that twenty-five million evangelical Christians did not vote. We need to be reminded that we must put legs to our prayers. While prayer is the main thing, there are practical corollaries fundamental to being a good steward of the government which God has entrusted to us. Last month, I noted that this is important information that requires serious concentration so don't be tempted to speed read without action. The five duties are pray, register, become informed, help elect godly people and vote. Voting in America has consequences.

PRAY

Your first duty as a Christian citizen is to pray. For the four and one-half decades beginning in 1976, the matter of prayer has consumed much of my waking hours. To carry out God's mandate for me, I have traveled around the world teaching the primacy of prayer in God's plan. To encapsulate my message, prayer is the work that must come before all other work. God has ordained prayer as the tool to get His work accomplished. Among the most effective resources Christians have to rescue and strengthen our nation is the power of prayer. As we pray in faith, believing God, we can have confidence that He will work through our nation's leaders and citizens to bring about changes for His glory and our good. If you desire to begin making a significant contribution to America:

- PRAY that God will truly possess your own life, and give you the Holy Spirit's power to lead others to receive Christ as Savior and Lord.
- PRAY for the millions of people in our country who don't know Christ as Lord and Savior. Ask God to send a great spiritual awakening to America.
- PRAY that Christians will dedicate themselves to God for spiritual living and active service with the family, church, and nation.
- PRAY daily that God will change or remove from positions of public leadership officials
 who are godless carnal, and disobedient to Him, so that righteous rule will be restored, and
 America will turn from her wicked ways. Godless rule is contagious. As King Solomon said,
 A wicked ruler will have wicked aides on his staff (Proverbs 29:12).

PRAY daily that men and women of God will be elected to public office at all levels
of leadership local, state, and national so that our land will be healed and our
people will rejoice in righteous rule. Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord
(Psalm 33:12).

God will not ignore the prayers of those who trust in Him. He clearly admonishes Christians who are concerned about the welfare of their nation: If My people called by My name will humble themselves and pray, and seek My face [search for Me], and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from Heaven, forgive their sins and heal their land (2 Chronicles 7:14). We must pray if we desire to see God's continual blessings and protection upon our country.

Through prayer, we can also seek the leadership of qualified people who honor God. It is His plan that righteous people or those who trust Him lead our country. For the wicked shall not rule the godly, lest the godly be forced to do wrong (Psalm 125:3).

REGISTER TO VOTE

The second duty of citizenship is to register to vote. In order to serve God as a citizen, you must become a regularly participating voter. You cannot vote until you have registered your name and address and other required information with the proper authorities.

Millions of God's people are not registered to vote. How can we as Christian citizens expect God to restore righteous leadership through us unless we are willing to take a few minutes to register? Only when you have registered to vote will you be in a position to help assure the election of godly officials. If you are not familiar with registration procedures, call your local town, city, or county office for information. The good influence of godly citizens causes a city (state or nation) to prosper (Proverbs 11:11).

BECOME INFORMED

Your third duty as a Christian citizen is to become informed. Just as an untrained soldier is at the mercy of his enemy, the uninformed Christian is incapable of prevailing against the forces of evil in the world of politics. In order to serve God effectively as a citizen of our country, you must know how to act for His glory within the framework of existing political processes.

As you read your Bible daily, be alert to any passage the Holy Spirit alerts you. It may be a passage citing God's righteousness, His justice, His pleasure in holy living, His disdain for idolatry, violence, and such. God has spoken of living a quiet, peaceful life. As you develop this mindset, you will be amazed at how relevant the Bible is in regard to our culture and society. You will soon become acquainted with what God calls abominations in His sight. As a guide, you might want to list the abominations and use them in your pursuit of becoming an informed voter.

Listen and ponder any information that comes your way realizing that we are inundated with fake news.

Have conversation with Christian friends. Sue and I are blessed to sit under a pastor who declares the whole counsel of God with application to all aspects of life, including Christian citizenship. Don't let anything hinder your progress toward becoming a well-informed citizen. Delay can be fatal to America.

As I write this, one of the two major political parties in America is nominating their candidates for President and Vice-President. Each party has what is called their platform—delineating their core beliefs.

Take time to read the platforms. Are their statements whose implementation will parallel Scripture positively or negatively? Listen to any statements from leaders of the parties.

HELP ELECT GODLY PEOPLE

Your fourth duty as a Christian citizen is to help elect godly people. The Bible tells us, With good men in authority, the people rejoice, but with the wicked in power, they groan (Proverbs 29:2B). The most effective way to restore righteous rule and rejoicing in America is to elect godly people to positions of authority. This can be done by praying, informed Christians by people like you.

. The Word of God gives directions for evaluating the people who are running for public office. Notice: I apply the laws of God . . . Find some capable, godly, honest men who hate bribes, and . . . let these men be responsible to serve the people with justice at all times (**Exodus 18:16b,21-22**). From this passage of Scripture, there are six qualifications that stand out: (1) godliness; (2) integrity; (3) industriousness; (4) biblical guidance; (5) justice; (6) demonstrated capability (or competence in managing business or professional affairs). These God-given standards should be applied carefully and prayerfully in selecting your candidate.

When you have decided on the most qualified candidates, take action to help them be elected. The key to victory for your candidate is the local political precinct. Secure the official precinct maps covering the district in which your candidate is running for office. When possible become a precinct captain and encourage other Christians to take responsibility. Through the precinct, the foot work will be organized for your area. God's people can and must occupy the precincts with an active role in selecting godly candidates, introducing them to the citizens in your precinct, and working toward their election. Make your candidate known by word of mouth and distributing literature. Remember you and I are the salt of the earth. It is important that the salt get out of the salt shaker! Your very presence as a Christian citizen can make a tremendous difference. Be a blessing to others and your own life will be richly blessed.

VOTE

Your fifth duty as a Christian citizen is to vote. Only when you cast your vote do you fulfill your Christian responsibility in government. Exercise the citizen influence that God has given you through the unique system of self-government. If you fail to vote conscientiously for godly rule, evil will increase in our nation. It is often said that decisions in America are made by a majority of the people. This is not so. Decisions are made by a majority of those who vote.

Remember when deciding for whom you should vote, let the Word of God be your guide. Also, make a sincere effort to obtain reliable information about all issues and candidates before casting your vote. If no qualified Christian candidate is available, vote for the person whose principles and platform most nearly agree with your own Christian position based on the Bible. As Christians we must be faithful to fulfill our responsibility of participating in our government.

Martin's Van

Martin Shikuku is a remarkable servant of the Lord Jesus Christ who lives in West Kenya in the beautiful Rift Valley in Eldoret. The Sovereign God whom we serve "ordained" that we should become bonded in ministry. "Sovereign" means the "One Who has final say;" "ordained" means "laid out ahead of time." Martin was my student in a course on prayer that I taught at Brackenhurst, the Baptist retreat near Nairobi, in April 2006.

As our relationship developed, it was abundantly clear that Martin intended to implement fully what he had learned in the course. Nothing short of acknowledging that God

has done a great work through this Baptist pastor, his family, and his congregation would be proper. Based on the fruit he is gathering from his labors, the JGHM Board decided to focus on his ministry in East/Central Africa as a wise use of the funds entrusted to us by the Ropeholder/Doorkeepers. Your investment is paying big dividends.



In 2006, Martin did not have transportation other than walking, taxi, or bus. He had never been in a plane. **JGHM** was able to provide a small sedan that greatly enhanced his ministry. We later upgraded to a van. Last year, Martin made it known that his van needed to be replaced. Using that van as a trade-in and \$9,000 given by the **Doorkeepers** in response to an appeal, Martin purchased a Toyota van for \$22,851.76. We have now been able to pay the final \$4,000.
