

Two Christmas miracles revealed in Luke 1-2 Armin Gesswein (11/28/1907-3/10/2001)

As did many, I counted Armin Gesswein my friend. God used him mightily to mobilize prayer warriors across the nation. He was the Southern California Billy Graham Crusade prayer chairman, the event that launched the Billy Graham ministry. For many years, he was a steady encourager to me in keeping on with the prayer seminar ministry. When God called him home, I promised to do all I can to keep his ministry alive. It is with joy that I yield my space in the December Reflector to a lesson from this great teacher.

It has been said when God is about to do something wonderful He begins with a difficulty; when He is about to do something very wonderful He begins with an impossibility. These are exactly the two wonders we face when we open the Christmas gospel of St. Luke, which Renan said was "the most beautiful book ever written."

We read of the difficulty in Luke 1: the birth of John the Baptist, who Jesus (later) said was the greatest of all the prophets. He was born to a godly old priest and his wife Elizabeth who was "barren" and when both were past the age of child-bearing.

The angel Gabriel appeared to the aged priest in the temple in Jerusalem beside the incense altar of prayer with these words: "Fear not, Zacharias, your prayer is heard; your wife Elizabeth shall bear you a son, and you shall call his name John. He will be great ... Many of the children of Israel will he turn to the Lord ... to prepare a people that is ready for the Lord" (Luke 1:13ff).

In the same chapter of Luke, we read of the impossibility: the birth of Jesus by the virgin Mary through the Holy Spirit without a human father. It was the same angel, Gabriel, six months later, who appeared to Mary and spoke these words: "Have no fear, Mary, for

Christmas: A reminder and a celebration! God became a man.

In the 11th century, Anselm of Canterbury probed the meaning of the atonement more deeply than had the early church fathers. His explanation was given in a treatise called Cur Deus Homo, "Why Did God Become Man?"

Anselm explained that sin is a revolt against God. a revolt to which God must respond by providing for justice. Thus the sinner is helpless under the wrath of God. "For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the trust in unrighteousness" (Romans 1:18). How can God forgive the sinner and still remain just and holy? There was only one way: sins must be paid for, So God, in love, chose to take the required penalty for us by Christ's death on the cross.

This is why God became man. It was only by taking our place on the cross and taking the penalty for our sins, that God could offer us pardon without denying His justice.

you have found favor with God ... You will conceive in your womb and give birth to a son, and you shall call Him Jesus. He shall be great and shall be called Son of the Highest, and the Lord God shall give him the throne of His father David ... there shall be no end to His kingdom (Luke 1:30ff).

When Mary asked how this was to happen, since she had not had any "relations" with a man, the angel said: "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow you; therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of you shall be called the Son of God" (Luke 1:34-35). Mary did not doubt, and God said: "Blessed is she that believed ... with God nothing shall be impossible" (Luke 1:37,45).

Both, said the angel Gabriel, would be "GREAT." How wonderful. These two miracle babies became the two "greats" who ushered in the whole New Testament Christian era which changed our world.

From these two births we learn some amazing lessons about prayer. God loves to answer prayer, hide His great power, and do things in His own unique way.

And we should know that no matter what the **difficulty**, nothing is too hard for God. And that "with God nothing shall be impossible."

ANOTHER YEAR, Armin wrote a treatise on "Christmas", entitled "I wonder as I wonder."

No one was ever born like Jesus, born of the virgin Mary by the Holy Spirit. No one ever lived like Jesus, "holy, harmless, undefiled, and separate from sinners." The perfect Son of God was He. No one ever spoke

like Jesus, so said a Roman soldier. No one ever did the works that Jesus did. "I have done the works which no man ever has done," He said.

No one ever died like Jesus "to take away the sins of the world!" No one ever rose again from the grave like Jesus. He rose again the third day, as He said. No one ever ascended to Heaven like Jesus, in a cloud of glory. No one ever reigned on a Throne like Jesus, "King of kings, and Lord of lords." No one ever prays like Jesus. He "ever lives to pray and make intercession for us" (Hebrews 7:25). No one will ever come again like Jesus. "This same Jesus who was taken up shall so come as you have seen Him go into heaven" said two angels to all who saw Him go (Acts 1:11). No one will ever reign forever as Jesus. "Thy Kingdom come ... for THINE IS THE KINGDOM, AND THE POWER, AND THE GLORY FOREVER. AMEN. THIS WE PRAY WITH FULL AND FINAL ASSURANCE.

As Armin spoke to thousands upon thousands in his seventy-year ministry, those who heard him had no doubt that indeed he was filled with Wonder. As I re-read his words once again, as I do every Christmas when I go through my Christmas folder, his words are as vibrant as ever and

there is no doubt that He was filled with <u>Wonder</u> as he shared his heart. Let's sit where he sat as he wrote.

"Delivered and Accepted"

Before her death, Grace Copeland wrote a witnessed statement that she was giving all of her household goods to Mr. and Mrs. G. Lewis of Logansport, Indiana, as a token of their kindness to her. After her death, however, the executor of the estate won a Switzerland Circuit Court verdict barring the Lewises from obtaining the furnishings, saying they belonged to the estate.

The Lewises went to court.

The verdict of the Indiana Appellate Court: "In order to have been legally given, a gift must have been delivered and accepted!"

This is certainly true in redemption. John 3:16 says: "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life."

However, before the gift of eternal life becomes a reality in an individual's life, that gift must be "delivered and accepted." The Holy Spirit delivers the gift through conviction in the heart. It does not belong to the recipient, however, until he has "accepted" it.

Myriads will be in Hell for whom the gift of salvation was intended, but who refused to accept the gift when it was proffered by the Holy Spirit through the Word of God.

2014 Venezuela Report

Love flowed freely from the participants and a spirit of excitement prevailed in each seminar.

JGHM has had the opportunity to mobilize more prayer warriors in beautiful Venezuela. Thank you for providing the prayer and financial support to make the ninth visit possible.

There were ten prayer seminars, nine in churches and one by radio (five hours). We touched Caracas (the capital city with its five million people). Then we flew to El Vigia in Merida State. From there we drove into the Andes Mountain to La Azulita, a beautiful resort town on the side the mountain. When we returned to Caracas, there were several prayer seminars in what is known as the Ghetto perched on one of the mountains around the city. 500,000 live in La Vega. As you go up the mountain,

communities are named. We ended our work in what is known as 'the towers," where a Christian radio station is located.

There was a deep moving of the Holy Spirit touching hearts and bringing the Word alive. Not only were a large number saved, a much larger number renewed their commitment to the Lord Jesus Christ and His Gospel. Individuals were revived and churches strengthened.

As I look at the map of Venezuela and circle the areas where we have taught prayer seminars, this nation joins a few other nations that have been widely influenced by the prayer seminar ministry. Even on this trip, a number came forward to say that they had been in a seminar in

earlier years and had been blessed by what happened to them.

From Caracas the first week, Adam and I traveled to nearby Vargas State (where the international airport is located) to speak on a Christian radio station, Radio Ondas de Victoria 106.9 FM. Our hosts were Juan Moron Arreaza, owner-manager of the station, and his wife, Dr. Yadina. She is the Chief Medical Officer for the State of Vargas. Both are literally on fire for the Lord Jesus Christ and His Gospel.

Tentative agreement has been given to return to Venezuela and provide prayer seminars in the eleven regions of that State.

During our conversations, they did not mention a personal tragedy that occurred a few months ago in their own family. Their beautiful daughter and her husband were murdered in a car-jacking. It was obvious that the two had tender hearts and a great love for God, the Father, and His Son, the Lord Jesus. It will be a joy to work with them. Hopefully, we will return in 2015.

The second amazing thing that they did not tell us is quite thrilling. Dr. Yadina has recently won the Governor of the State of Vargas to the Lord and they are disciplining him!

At the close of the prayer seminar that they attended in Caracas, they introduced themselves and waiting patiently for Adam to become available to interpret. Simply, we bonded! God is good.
