LOOKING BACK OVER SIXTY-THREE YEARS OF MINISTRY 1953- 2016

The November 2016 Reflector was a special one for me personally. A glimpse of our lives in the 1960s was included. Being able to sit again in the meetinghouses of the Ringgold Baptist Church, Ringgold, Virginia and the Shenandoah Valley Baptist Church, Stephens City, Virginia, brought joy unspeakable. In a recent telephone conversation with Pastor Gene Jones, he shared our being back in Shenandoah Valley Baptist Church was well received by the congregation and the church wanted to schedule an all-day Sunday prayer seminar as quickly as possible. My response was a simple one: "I enjoyed every minute of being back." The prayer seminar is scheduled for all-day, Sunday, January 15, 2017.

From the beginning of my pastoral ministry in 1957, I understood the value of a Sunday bulletin and a special publication that would go into the homes during the week. Of course, the weekly publication was the **Reflector**. Although the **REFLECTOR** is no longer a weekly paper, it will enter its 63rd year of publication in January 2017.

Thankfully, we do have issues of the **Reflector** in the ministry archives. Folders holding the Sunday bulletins were given to the churches where I pastored for their archives. Hopefully, these are stored safely and available for anyone wishing to read them. This was done for posterity.

The value of bulletins and the **Reflectors** is that each was prepared with two purposes in mind—information and inspiration. We wanted our readers to be informed about what was going on so they could attend activities and provide prayer support. I filled them with articles to inspire them in their Christian walk, pressing truth into the hearts and minds of our people. As I ran across deep thoughts crystallized into a few words, I filed them for future use. Often we have received comments when some feature in the **Reflector**

Christmas: A reminder and a celebration that God became a man. penalty paid!

In the 11th century, Anselm of Canterbury probed the meaning of the atonement more deeply than had the early church fathers. His explanation was given in a treatise called Cur Deus Homo, "Why Did God Become Man?"

Anselm explained that sin is a revolt against God, a revolt to which God must respond by providing for justice. Thus the sinner is helpless under the wrath of God. "For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the trust in unrighteousness" (Romans 1:18). How can God forgive the sinner and still remain just and holy? There was only one way: sins must be paid for, So God, in love, chose to take the required penalty for us by Christ's death on the cross.

This is why God became man. It was only by taking our place on the cross and taking the penalty for our sins, that God could offer us pardon without denying His justice.

touched hearts. Some say that they share articles with members of their Sunday school classes or other friends.

During the course of my studying and reading, I have always tried to gather "nuggets" along the way and make a note of them in the margins and blank leaves of my Bible. I strongly recommend this approach to pastors and teachers. I have found this a useful approach, preserving for use many thoughts and apt sayings that would have escaped my memory.

"Notes from My Bible" is the harvest of many years' gathering. Although some of these thoughts are original, not all of them are. The flowers have been culled from many gardens. I would be glad to give full credit to the men and women to whom I am indebted by attaching their names to their sayings; but I found that this could be done only very partially, and therefore decided to omit names in every instance.

Making notes is something you can do. When you write them in your Bibles, you might very well touch the lives of your children, grandchildren or other family members after you are home in Heaven.

Many of the articles that I am using in the December 2016 Reflector come from the late 1960s--from Reflectors or Sunday bulletins. Enjoy. Use these as stimulators to review your own notes--written on paper or written in your brain. May Christmas 2016 add to those memories of things you want to remember and cherish.


We must stand in the gap remembering to continue prayer work as "watchmen upon the walls who never hold their peace day nor night" (Isaiah 62:6).

Sixteen men make daily decisions that affect the course of our nation and our freedom. Their decisions either acknowledge God's authority, or force us to disregard His laws. These sixteen men are the President, the two Senators from your state, the U. S. Congressman from your

district, the Governor of your state, your State Senator, your State representative, and the nine Supreme Court Justices. We have an obligation under God to intercede for these men (1 Timothy 2:1-2).

During the prayer seminar and in the Prayer Seminar Workbook (pages 8,29), ideas are given for daily intercession. One suggestion is to organize prayer items using the days of the week as reminders. Wednesday could be tagged "Washington" or "White House" to remind us to pray for those in authority over us. Pray that they would:

- 1. Receive Christ as Savior and realize their personal sinfulness and their need for daily cleansing by the washing of water through the Word and daily cleansing by the blood of the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 2. Recognize their personal inadequacies to fulfill their personal responsibility and that they would consciously depend upon God for knowledge, wisdom, and the courage to do what is right.
- 3. Reject all counsel that violates spiritual principles, trusting God to prove them right.
- 4. Resist those who would pressure them to violate their conscience.
- 5. Reverse the trends of humanism which deify man rather than God.
- 6. Be ready to sacrifice personal ambitions and political careers in the best interest of our nation.
- 7. Rely upon prayer and the Word of God as the source of daily strength, wisdom and courage.
- 8. Conduct their office with dignity, honor, trustworthiness, and righteousness.
- 9. Remember to be good examples. 10. Be reminded daily that they are accountable to God for their decisions



BUT DON'T FORGET. God never said that HEALING FOR A NATION will emanate from the government or education. Rather, He said healing for a nation will come when His children who are called by His name: (1) humble themselves in a spirit of God-dependence, not self-dependence; (2) pray for Him to act (His hand move). (3) seek His face in worship and praise, (4) turn from sin (2 Chronicles 7:14). Healing for a nation comes from God through His children. Remember Daniel identified himself with the sins of His children and said "we" have sinned, not "they." Confession must be specific, not general. What are we doing that God does want us to do? What are we not doing that He wants us to do? REPENT!
