

HIS SON, THE LORD JESUS CHRIST

THE ONLY WAY TO HEAVEN!

Celebrate! Biblical mystery of the Lord Jesus Christ! Christmas! The time to celebrate the wisdom of God!

"Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and His ways past finding out! 'For who has known the mind of the Lord? Or who has become His counselor? Or who has first given to Him and it shall be repaid to him?' For of Him and through Him are all things, to whom be glory forever. Amen" (Romans 11:33-36).

In Scripture, "mystery" is a technical theological term. It identifies some previously hidden or only hinted at facet of God's eternal plan, which has only recently been revealed. As used so often by Paul (Romans 11:25; 16:25; 1 Corinthians 2:7; Ephesians 1:9; 3:3, 4, 9), "mystery" does not mean something incomprehensible. It means something that had been kept secret and has now been disclosed. Paul uses the word to speak of a secret that has been openly revealed to all. Christ, Paul realized with wonder, is the greatest of the mysteries of God.

Christmas is the time to celebrate the unsearchable wisdom of God. God chose to create man in His own image. Instead of being robots, men can make choices. Most readers of the Reflector know "the rest of the story." The die was cast in the Garden of Eden when man chose to disobey God's clearly delineated command. In God's infinite wisdom, as He dealt with the fall of Adam and Eve (representing all mankind), He had a plan to bring salvation to mankind. You and I would do well to ponder Genesis 3:15, a passage that is sometimes called the "first gospel" because these words, as

indirect as they are, promise the Coming One whom we know to be the Lord Jesus, the Messiah. The Lord was showing mercy even as He judged. "And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed: He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel." "Enmity between you and the woman" is not just about snakes; it is about the enemy of our souls, Satan. The Seed of the woman is the promise of a child. The Seed of the woman is the Promised One, the coming Messiah of Israel. "Bruise His heel" speaks of a serious injury, but it is contrasted with the "bruising of the head"-the defeat-of the serpent's seed. When Jesus went to the cross, He was bruised in his heel. That is, He suffered a terrible but temporary injury (John 12:31; Colossians 2:15). In His resurrection. Christ defeated His enemy.

The hard reality is **that one** of God's attributes is that He is righteous and just. This means that sin carries a price that must be paid. God's moral standards are eternally valid. He cannot simply overlook sin and retain this attribute. The penalty for sin must be exacted. God's plan of salvation is illustrated by the principle of substitution. In dealing with the woman's sin, the Lord turned first to the serpent and brought His judgment—a curse—on him. God did not excuse the woman because she was deceived, but He did bring the harsher judgment on the one who deceived her.

How could God forgive the sins of past saints? How could God not simply declare human beings righteous in His sight, but actually make

them righteous? How could God, committed as He was to the Jews, open wide His arms to the Gentiles too? How could Jew and Gentile ever find common ground, enabling the race to be drawn back together into one? How could God's love for all the human race be so stunningly displayed that hardened sinners would suddenly halt, reconsider, and kneel, broken, before God?

Some years ago during my early morning praying, the Holy Spirit led me to praise God for His wisdom in developing a plan to enable Him to be "just and the justifier" of those who believe. To sum up His plan, God "made [His Son] who knew no sin to become sin for us that we might become the righteousness of God in Him" (2 Corinthians 5:21). The **substitute** is in place and God's wrath against sin has been satisfied. The word "propitiation" means the appeasement of divine wrath by a sacrificial offering. Sending Christ to die for our sins was God's amazing solution to the problem of how He could remain just (punish all sin) and still justify us (declare us perfectly righteous in His sight). Oh, the depth of His wisdom!

These and all of history's unanswered questions are, for Paul, answered in Jesus Christ. He is the mystery hidden for long ages past. He is the One glimpsed in prophetic writings. He is the One who has come and stands fully revealed today that all nations might believe and obey Him. He is the One who at last enabled us to sense not only the love but also the wisdom of God. He is the One through whom God receives glory, forever and ever.

We love the One whose coming

explained the mystery of God's plan, and revealed once and for all the full extent of His mysterious, wonderful love. In God's wisdom, His plan of salvation was put into place. Since the life of the flesh is in the blood. blood must be a factor. Initially, it was the blood of an innocent animal, one without spot or blemish. Down through the ages, the shedding of the blood of the animal was accepted, but each time it was an act pointing to the Lamb of God who would come and take away the sin of the world. Mankind awaited His arrival. Then came the day of the arrival of the child in Bethlehem, Mary's Son. Thirty-three years passed and then came the Cross, the day when He who had no sin became sin for us. His blood was shed ONCE FOR ALL. Let's celebrate the wisdom of God and His plan for mankind.

The December 2018 theme of the **Reflector** is to celebrate the wisdom of God and His plan of redemption completed in the birth, life, death, and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ. "Oh. how I love Jesus!" Christmas is a time to ponder and reflect on God and His wisdom in providing a means of salvation for all who place their faith in Jesus Christ in genuine reliance on Him, a heartfelt trust in Him. The blood of Christ is forever the only means of a right relationship with God. A "But now" moment (Romans 3:21) is described beautifully by Paul which can become foundational in our celebrating God's Christmas gift: "Being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God

had passed over the sins that were previously committed [Old Testament era], to demonstrate at the present time His righteousness, that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus" (Romans 3:24-26).



We talk about "keeping Christ in Christmas," but how can we actually do that? As you move through Advent, here are 12 short, powerful prayers that can help you focus on the true meaning of Christmas.

- 1. <u>LOVE</u>. "Lord, help us follow the way of love; let the love of Christ compel us" (1 Corinthians 14:1-2; 2 Corinthians 5:14).
- 2. <u>JOY</u>. "Restore the joy of Your salvation to us; let us experience the joy of Your presence" (**Psalm 51:12**, **16:11**).
- 3. <u>PEACE</u>. "Let Your peace rule and guard our hearts; give us more of You, Jesus. You are our peace" (Colossians 3:15; Philippians 4:7; Ephesians 2:14).
- 4. <u>HOPE</u>. "Enlighten the eyes of our heart so that we may know the hope You called us to (**Ephesians 1:18**).
- 5. FAVOR. "Let Your favor rest on us" (Luke 2:52).
- 6. <u>LIFE</u>. "Shine Your light of life on us; help us to walk in it" (Job 33:30; Psalm 56:13).
- 7. <u>SALVATION</u>. "Help us to fear You so we can unlock the treasure of Your salvation" (Isaiah 33:6).
- 8. <u>SELFLESSNESS</u>. "Keep us from self-seeking attitudes that reject truth" (Romans 2:8).
- 9. <u>GENEROSITY</u>. "Make us rich in ways that result in generosity on our part so You will be praised" (2 Corinthians 9:11).
- 10. <u>RECEIVING</u>. "Help us receive Your kingdom, Your Spirit, and Your grace" (Daniel 7:18; John 20:22; Romans 5:17).
- 11. <u>SEEKING</u>. "Encourage us to seek Your face with all our hearts" (Deuteronomy 4:29; Psalm 27:8).
