

#### MEET SHALOM SHIKUKU

DAILY TIME IN THE WORD. For the past few years, MARTIN SHIKUKU has started his day with his Bible in hand in systematic, devotional reading following the through-the-Bible program published in the monthly Reflector. "Systematic" is reading the Bible chapter-by-chapter (three chapters a day and five on Sunday, one can read through the Bible in a year); some recommend to read for at least fifteen minutes. "Devotional" means letting God speak to your heart to get you ready for the day—not to be confused with more formal study for information! After you hear God speak to your heart, you are then ready to speak to Him in prayer. This way is so profitable spiritually that Satan will do everything in his power to thwart such an approach. The battle for the mind begins! For those who have learned to put on the armor that God has provided for our protection, Satan has no entrance (Ephesians 6:10-18) and must flee.

The first thing Martin did after his very first prayer seminar experience in April 2006 was to prepare a written document with his commitments based on what God had taught him. Among the

items that he listed was daily, devotional Bible reading as his spiritual food. Often Martin shares some special blessing that he has received in his Bible study. He recently wrote: "Thanks my teacher, for teaching me this way of feeding from the Word of God each day." His children are following His example. Martin continues, "Psalms is so rich. On Friday, my children were in Psalm 78. My son Shalom told me that reading the Bible is very good. Shalom said, 'God does not want to hide anything from His children. He wants us to know everything.' He said that reading the Bible teaches him English as well—A VERY PROFITABLE TIME.

Martin is founder-pastor of Glory Baptist Church in Eldoret, West Kenya (beautiful Rift Valley, home of the famous Kenyan runners). He is forty-two and is the director of the newly formed JGHM--East/Central Africa Branch. His wife is Anne who is 37. # MILITARY CHAPLAINCY UNDER ATTACK

The U.S. Army Chaplain Corps is one of the oldest and smallest branches of the Army. The Chaplain Corps dates back to 29 July 1775, when the Continental Congress authorized one chaplain for each regiment of the Continental Army, with pay equaling that of a captain. In addition to chaplains serving in Continental regiments, many militia regiments counted chaplains among their ranks.

A very special blessing has been to conduct prayer seminars on many military bases around the world. The reality is that one touches many families in many states represented in our military. The prayer seminars on military bases have been well received. The catalyst is always the chaplain(s).

Nancy Dietsch, in a training session for VA chaplains in San Diego, California, said that the policy of the VA is that chaplains should not pray in the name of Jesus. In a later discussion on faith, one of the chaplains quoted Hebrews 11:1. Dietsch told him he was not allowed to quote Scripture in class. Please pray specifically that the chaplains serving in the U. S. Military would be able to work within the framework of religious liberty. It is time for Christians to stand up!

#### Taking a stand

Since the late 1970s, Terry and Sonya Craig, have been special friends. Terry and I share birth years. Both of us were saved in the same year. More formally, he is Terrance R. Craig, Lt. Col. USAF (Retired). When we became friends he was ending a long and distinguished career at the Pentagon and was assigned to Langley Air Force Base in Newport News, Virginia. Upon his retirement, I strongly urged Dr. Jerry Falwell to name Terry the chief financial officer at Liberty Baptist College (now Liberty University), Lynchburg, Virginia, where I was serving as a consultant following my tenure as the VP for Academic Affairs. Terry and Sonja, however, had other plans and relocated to East Tennessee near my hometown. He held positions with Knoxville College and Tusculum, Tennessee's oldest institution of higher education. The Craigs have been faithful Doorkeepers with monthly contributions since JGHM was founded.

Terry has a message that every American needs to consider. It was drafted as a LETTER TO THE EDITOR at The Greenville Sun (TN). I encourage you to stand with Terry and share the letter as often and as widely as possible.

## PRESIDENT OBAMA'S WAR ON CHRISTIANITY

The biggest threat to our religious liberty today comes from the Federal Government of the United States of America within the very Pentagon where I once worked.

President Barack H. Obama and his civilian appointees have been slowly, but surely, chipping away at military discipline, readiness, and morale.

First, it was the banning of Christian Bibles in war zones like Afghanistan. Then it was the repeal of "Don't ask, don't tell" and forcing open homosexuality on our nation's military, for the first time in the history of our nation, at a time of great stress on military personnel and their families.

Soon afterward, without any thought to the practicable consequences, President Barak H. Obama and his followers announced women would be placed in direct combat roles.

Now comes an assault on Christianity and religious liberty in the United States Military:

An outright ban on open expression of Christian faith ANYWHERE in the United States Armed Forces!

Secretary of Defense Hagel and other civilian appointees are working with the anti-Christian Mikey Weinstein to develop policies that could result in court-martial procedures to punish Christians in the military who express, or share their faith.

Weinstein is the head of the "Military Religious Freedom Foundation." He has publicly stated that Christians, including chaplains, sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ in the military are guilty of "treason" and are "enemies of the Constitution."

Weinstein and his fellow secularists and atheists in charge of President Obama's Pentagon are serious and as a result, Christian soldiers, airmen, and marines are now in serious jeopardy. Being convicted in a court-martial means an Armed Service member has committed a crime under Federal Military Law. Punishment can include being Dishonorably Discharged from the military and even imprisoned.

If Weinstein and his Obama Pentagon allies have their way, the United States Military will soon remove all references to Christianity and make it a crime under military law for anyone to openly share or express [his or her] faith. This new policy would also forbid a chaplain from saying anything about his faith that someone could claim was encouraging

another service member to make that faith a part of his life.

Since the days of General George Washington, chaplains have been an essential part of the United States Military. Teaching the Christian Faith and ministering to the spiritual needs of the troops and providing counsel, instruction, and comfort to those in need; but, most importantly assisting them to be ready to meet God in case they are killed in the next battle.

Even today our men and women in uniform, especially our chaplains, are being threatened with their careers by the Obama-led defense department should they biblically speak out against homosexuality or gay marriage.

A senior master sergeant, who is described as a strong Christian, the first sergeant of a training unit at Lackland Air Force Base was relieved of his duties and is now facing court-martial charges for insubordination. His crime, when asked by his commanding officer, a Lesbian, "I need to know ... if you can see discrimination if some body says that they don't agree with homosexual marriage;" the senior master sergeant declined to answer in accordance with the Air Force policy which demands silence from homosexual detractors.

They do not want to control only our action and speech, they want to control our minds, our very soul and spirit, and if they cannot, they will destroy you. Recently a field grade officer was punished for having a Holy Bible on his desk.

The United States Military is being systematically de-Christianized, and Dr. Alan Keys, one of President Reagan's ambassadors to the United Nations, wrote in his letter that we have a report that the military leaders who refuse to pledge to shoot and kill American civilians are being purged from the United States Military leadership. Numerous high-ranking commanders from across all our military services have already been abruptly leaving their service

assignments.

In addition the Combating Terrorism Center at West Point is teaching cadets, our future officers, that citizens who believe in the Constitution, civil activism, individual freedoms, and self-government are potential domestic terrorists.

President Barack H. Obama, using the power of the Department of Justice, demonstrated his hostility to the religious rights of churches when he started telling them whom they could and could not hire as ministers. But, the Supreme Court voted unanimously against President Obama to protect the church's religious rights.

President Barack H. Obama, using unconstitutional regulations, imposed such high penalties on employers who refuse to fund abortion-inducing drugs that the penalties would put them out of business, if they don't provide the life-killing drugs. And, when employers seek exemption for religious reasons this same administration claims it has the power to determine what is religious and what is not, though hundreds of exemptions have been granted for other reasons.

Advocates of the homosexual legal agenda are demanding that we be forced to approve and celebrate their agenda. When a New Mexico artist declined to use her photography talents to celebrate a same-sex commitment, instead of seeking the service of another photograper, the homosexuals took her to court to compel her to do that which would violate her Christian beliefs. When the court ruled against her, one justice wrote that the photographer and her husband "now are compelled by law to compromise the very beliefs that inspire their lives," adding, "It is the price of citizenship.

The Constitution clearly states "congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof."

Anti-Christian activists are firmly entrenched in Washington D.C. They know that for at least three more years, they will have our tax dollars and very

powerful friends in the White House to help them advance their agenda. That means attacks on the sanctity of life, marriage, and family, and our religious liberties will intensify in 2014. The Obama Administration will advance its secular agenda, appointing more and more left-wing judges.

Legal advocates of homosexual behavior will push their agenda in all fifty states. Pro-abortion activists will use Obama Care to try to force us to pay to end the lives of even more innocent pre-born children. Radical atheists will challenge more Christian expressions of faith and memorials, and bully schools and local governments to remove them. More and more Christians will be told to sit down, shut up, or be punished.

Don't sit down! Don't shut up! Don't accept punishment! We Christians need to put on the full armor of God, humble ourselves, pray, seek God's face, and repent of our sins; and then stand up for our Savior, stand up for our God-given Constitution, stand up for our God-given rights.

Then [speak out], compel our local, state, and federal representatives to faithfully fulfill their oath to preserve, protect, and defend the Constitution of the United States of American and represent our Christian convictions. We Christians should vote only for conservative Christian candidates, known to be faithful to the Savior, the Constitution, and our Christian convictions. AND NEVER GIVE IN, NEVER GIVE IN, NEVER, NEVER GIVE IN!

### SIN HAS CONSEQUENCES

We are witnessing society being torn from its moral foundations. Areas of society that most American Christians felt that would never be disputed have come under attack. What I call "the big three"—religious liberty, the sanctity of human life, marriage and family—are under relentless assault by the Obama Administration, the American Civil Liberties Union, and even judges who are elected for life without accountability.

Many Christian leaders in the past have warned the church about the danger of secular humanism and how insipid its tenacles are in reaching out to corrupt and control society. The late Dr. Robert G. Lee, my hero, saw the doors that were being opened to turn the "land of free and the home of the brave" into the "land of the rave and home of the spree." He warned of sin's consequences in his famous sermon, "Payday, Some day."

The influence of evil is no longer working behind the scenes, but is open. Sadly, the leaders of this attack are in high places. The goals set by secular humanists are being achieved. A major goal is the removal of absolute moral standards from public education, from business, and from courts of law.

Earlier, I asked our readers to take a stand for biblical standards as did our forefathers. Since the basic principle in intercessory praying is simply focusing the power of God on a person(s) or on a specific situation(s), it is important to be clear about what

is facing Christians both here and around the world. We are to **STAND UP FOR JESUS ON OUR KNEES**. This is God's way as revealed in the Scriptures; this is God's way today.

Anyone wishing to determine how God views homosexuality need only read Genesis 18:17-33;19:1-29; Leviticus 18:22; 20:13; Romans 1:18:32. The Bible identifies all homosexual acts as sin, labeling them detestable, degrading, sinful, shameful, indecent, and perverse. The implications of homosexuality for a society can easily be seen in the account of Sodom. Any society that condones, and then actually promotes such sin, as Sodom did, rushes headlong toward judgment.

It is one thing to love the sinner, as we are often urged to do. It is another to ignore the sin. Sodom reminds us that we are to confront the sins in our society, exposing them for what they are, while retaining a deep and loving concern for the sinner.

If we wish to warn others, including our family members and friends, that God has determined a day in which He will judge the living and the dead (Acts 18:31), we cannot remain quiet on moral issues. Unlike Lot, who compromised when he settled down in the wicked city, we must speak out. When he warned two young men engaged to his daughters that judgment was coming, his warnings were taken as a joke (Genesis 19:14). Lot had lived in Sodom too long without speaking out to be taken seriously.
