

Are you as dismayed and shocked as I am about the organized effort to get rid of God in the United States to make us a completely secular, humanistic society? Committees of Correspondence have been organized across America to generate letters and opposition to all things Christian in education, in government, and in society in general. When the first negative Supreme Court rulings came during the Warren Court in the 50's, Billy Graham noted that when a nation sows to the wind, it will reap a whirlwind. As we look at the wars (crime, drugs, immorality, pornography) being waged against America's moral values that have guided us historically, it is obvious that we are simply reaping what we have been sowing. As our moral code has disintegrated more and more with each passing year, there have been catastrophic results.

I love America! Over the years, we have been privileged to travel to many nations conducting the prayer seminars. Each trip has been a blessing; we have observed beautiful places and beautiful people. We are often overwhelmed by the natural beauty that our eyes behold. For example, the mountains in South Korea are unusually beautiful and 75% of Korea is mountainous! The South Koreans' decorum is characterized by a sweet humility. The grandeur of the scenery across South Africa is striking, indeed.

However, the best part of a trip is getting home! I love America! My land! My people! To me, cold chills move over my body when I see Old Glory waving in the breeze as it is doing along our driveway as I write.


Crisis in America. Nevertheless, my nation is in need of healing that can only come from God not education or the government. A few weeks ago, the news media announced that we have reached 313 million in our population. It seems to me Christians have become complacent and simply do not sense the crisis we are facing. Do you remember the 1960's and 70's? These are two decades that many would like not to remember! The futility that most of us felt toward the future was overwhelming as our cities burned. It seemed that everything that was nailed down came loose! Some declared that both God and the church were dead!


Christians awakened in late 70's and early 80's. In the late 70's and early 80's, Christians began to awaken and move to the forefront of influence. History affirms that the outcome of the 1980 elections was a direct result of their involvement. They registered voters and went to the polls. They not only voted for certain candidates; they voted against a number of Congressmen and Senators.

Since there were some changes that lessened the tension, the average Christian no longer feels concern. But conditions have deteriorated remarkably and the church continues to do business as usual. Christians are not even shocked by the immorality and violence all around us. Frankly, we have become desensitized by television! The looseness of morals in political, social, religious and business affairs no longer bothers us. Pornography in art exhibits is even paid for by government taxes and most Christians couldn't care less! The fall of several highly visible preachers makes the present danger of an anti-Christian backlash real indeed!

Does America really need healing or am I just shadow boxing? During the prayer seminar, we talk about current moral conditions in our country:

- 1. One of five Americans needs professional help because of emotional problems.
- 2. One of four babies born in America is born to an unwed mother
- 3. There are three abortions a minute.
- 4. One of four homes with children is headed by a single parent.
- 5. Eight of each one hundred young people attempt suicide each year; eighteen a day succeed.
- 6. The divorce rate is 60%.3.2 million are living together
- 3.2 million are living together unmarried.
- 7. There are 22.6 million problem drinkers/alcoholics (18 million adults and 4.6 million children/youth). We do not have figures for other substance abusers, but the number is high. Individual lives are wrecked leaving many homes dysfunctional.
- 8. There is one violent crime each 24 seconds.
- 9. There is one property crime each three seconds.
- 10. There is one rape each six minutes.
- 11. There is one murder each 28 minutes. The news media announced recently that the United States is the murder capital of the world.
- 12. There are 2.5 million children abused annually. Three children die daily from abuse and neglect.
- 13. The number of federal and state prison inmates zoomed to a record 703,687.
- 14. There are as many as three million homeless people in America many with children living on the streets.





15. There are one million runaways.

16. Each eighteen seconds a woman is battered.

America needs healing

There are few families untouched by the problems listed above. Violent crime is up over 400 percent since 1963, child abuse is up 300 percent, federal prosecution of politicians has increased 470 percent, and the number of reported cases of AIDS is up by 6000 percent since 1982. Even scores on college entrance exams taken by high school students have declined significantly since the early 60's. Yes, American needs healing.

What is wrong with the people in our nation that has turned "the land of the free and the home of the brave" into "the land of the spree and the home of the rave?" Could it be because we have left God out? We have "sown the wind" and "reaped a whirlwind" (Hosea 8:7), as did ancient Israel. Every effort is being made to remove God completely from our national life! Where will it stop?

TIMELESS TRUTH

"Woe to those who call evil good, and good evil; who put darkness for light, and light for darkness; who put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter" (Isaiah 5:20).

A "woe" is an exclamation, a cry of grief or anguish typically associated with divine judgment. In **Isaiah** 5:8-30, there is a series of

woes announced for specific sins that are particularly grievous. These are (1) creating large personal estates at the expense of poorer landholders (vv 8-10); (2) hedonistic living [Confirmed alcoholics who imbibe from morning until night feasting and carousing] showing "no regard for the deeds of the Lord (vv 11-17); (3) making evil a life's work and scoffing at divine judgment (vv 18-19); (4) calling evil good and good evil obliterating moral distinctions, denving the difference between good and evil (v 20); (5) relying on one's own counsel rather than revelation (v 21); and (6) failing to take governmental responsibilities soberly [judges who are heroes of drinking and who pervert justice through accepting bribes]. (vv 22-23).

God's judgment will surely fall on such a people, for each action described shows that "they have rejected the Law of the Lord Almighty; and spurned the word of the Holy One of Israel."

The sins that triggered the woes involve a reconstitution of society in ways that are contrary to God's teachings. A desire for wealth and personal pleasure is expressed in societal values that replace the values revealed by God. The good traditional values are replaced by evil new values, and scoffed at by those who are wise in their own eyes. Even those who administer the nation's laws accept the new values, and so "acquit the guilty for a bribe."

It may be hard to live by God's values in our own society. But it was hard in Bible times too! Only a firm commitment to God and His ways can guard us against evil influences that press in on every side.

Little commentary is needed to demonstrate that in many ways America has forsaken its moral compass that has guided us through the years. Without question, there is an open attack upon God (His words and His works]. One timeless truth is unchanged: GOD IS THE

MORAL RULER OF THE UNIVERSE. HE CAN AND DOES PUNISH THE WICKED.

One of the leading forces mobilizing prayer warriors is **Intercessors for America**. This group has been consistent and persistent in calling Christians to intercession for our nations. Their work has in many ways paralleled the prayer seminar ministry. They are seeking to enlist thousands willing to cry out to God for the restoration of our nation. My commitment is to join in the concerted praying. I have committed to 6 a.m. on Sunday mornings as a special time to pray for America. Of course, this does not mean this is the only time I will pray for my country but it will be my focus at this set time.

We need God's hand as never before in my lifetime. This movement is rooted in the following facts: (1) God is in charge of nations (Job 12:23); (2) God desires to bestow mercy (Jeremiah 18:7-10); and (3) God's mercy is directly tied to our humbling ourselves, asking His hand to move, seeking His face, and turning from sin; i.e., God's mercy is directly tied to our repentance (2 Chronicles 7:14).
