Briggs and Peggy have been special friends since the seventies. Forty-two years ago, I was their pastor at Pleasant View Baptist Church, Lynchburg, Virginia. Actually their love for their pastor was unparalleled. It was a joy to serve as evangelist for a revival meeting in White Oak Baptist Church, Morristown, Tennessee, my home church. When I came into the service one night, there sat Briggs, Peggy and their children. They had driven 275 miles to be with their pastor. The Holy Spirit was also present in a mighty way. Evangelistic songs were sung. The people prayed. The Word was preached. Then an invitation hymn was sung and an appeal was made: "Will thou be saved? Then why not tonight?" There was rejoicing in the presence of the Father in Heaven that night as a young man came to Christ. There was rejoicing at White Oak Baptist Church led by a mother whose prayers had been answered as she moved into the aisle shouting her praises to God. Revival, indeed, had come to White Oak! Thank God for "old friends!"

Thoughts about Heaven

There, the Father is seated on His throne of grace. There, the Lord Jesus Christ is seated at His right hand making intercession for us. There, angels are rejoicing around the throne along with the seraphim and cherubim. There, a great cloud of witnesses including Peggy (as well as many of our loved ones and Doorkeepers) are in that number. "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him" (1 Corinthians 2:9). John G. Paton 24 May 1824-28 January 1907 MISSIONARY TO TANNA TRIBE IN NEW HEBRIDES



When John and Mary Paton arrived on the island of Tanna in the southern part of New Hebrides on 5 November 1858 and built a small house at Port Resolution, neither understood the cost that they would pay to bring the gospel to this island. In those days the natives of Tanna were cannibals who were enveloped in the superstitions and cruelties of heathenism. The men and children went about in a state of nudity while the women wore abbreviated grass or leaf aprons. Three months after their arrival, a son, Peter Robert Robson, was born on 12 February 1859. But just nineteen days later, Mary died from tropical fever soon to be followed to the grave by the newly born Peter at thirty-six days. In spite of constant animosity from the natives and many attempts on his life, his work to reach this tribe continued.

One of Paton's modes was translating the New Testament into the native language. In spite of efforts to do so, he **CONTINUED ON PAGE FIVE**

Peggy's obituary said she had gone "home," a fitting thought for one who had traveled as a tour guide throughout forty-nine states and Canada for twenty years. Is your destination, Heaven? If not, it is time to get started on the way home!

Thoughts regarding the Road to Heaven

There is only one way to get on that road and it is to know and believe the Gospel as declared in 1 Corinthians 15:1-4, the "good news" of the death, burial and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ for our sins. Understand that "believe" is more than intellectual assent. "Believe" is to place your faith in the Lord Jesus Christ by trusting Him as your Savior and Lord. That plan is clearly laid out in Romans 10:8-13.

Some say that they have always loved Jesus and cannot remember when they did not do so. Such a statement is uttered in ignorance of Biblical teaching. Basic information is provided in the Biblical account recorded in Genesis 3. God created Adam, the first man, in His image and placed him into the beautiful Garden of Eden. His **body** was from the dust of the earth. Once the body was formed, God Himself breathed into it the breath of life (the human spirit), and man became a living soul (i.e. person with mind, emotions, and will). Man, therefore, is a **trichotomy**, not a **dichotomy**. As I write this article, our daily Bible reading in our annual trek through the Bible was Job 8-10. Sue and I discussed an insightful paragraph (10:8-12) that

provides information on how we are made. Clearly "Your hands have made me and fashioned me, an intricate unity ... Remember, I pray, that You have made me like clay ... Did you not pour me out like milk, and curdle me like cheese [human embroyo], clothe me with skin and flesh, and knit me together with bones and sinews? [the body]. You have granted me life and favor [soul], and Your care has preserved by spirit.", we are spirit, soul, and body.

When you look at me, you do not see the real me who lives inside the body, which is my "house" or my "tent." This in no way denigrates the importance of the body. We need to exercise wisdom in taking care of the body. But the real me, composed of soul-spirit lives inside the body. The word "death" means "separation." When dead comes, the person leaves his body and Christians go to be with the Lord as Paul so helpfully detailed in his treatise in **2 Corinthians 5:1**. 8. Paul's conclusion is "to be absent from the body is to be present with the Lord." Praise God!

Scripture states that God told Adam that he would "surely die" the day he ate the forbidden fruit in the garden. In disobedience, Adam ate the fruit. Did he die the day he ate the fruit? He did not die physically. He did not die as a person. The answer to the question is "yes." How did Adam die? He died spiritually in that his spirit died to God. The Scripture says that everyone born

URGENT! PRAY FOR STABILITY FOR VENEZUELA! since Adam has been born dead to God because of Adam's sin (Genesis 3). Consequently, it takes a new birth to get on the road to Heaven. Jesus explained to Nicodemus that a "new birth" was necessary to go to Heaven, but this "new birth" was not physical, but spiritual. A "new birth" happens when the Holy Spirit comes to live in your spirit the very moment you are saved. When a person hears and "believes" the Gospel and through "faith" places his "trust" in the Lord Jesus Christ.

Five things happen the moment you are saved. (1) Your name is written in the Lamb's Book of Life: (2) the Holy Spirit comes to live in your spirit and you have new life; (3) You are placed in the body of Christ (2 Corinthians 12:13), engulfed in the Body completely. You do not have a finger sticking out!. (4) You are given at least one spiritual gift to use to build up the body of Christ. These are called "charismatic gifts" which means a "grace" gift meaning you did not deserve or earn the gift. (5) You are placed on the road to Heaven and one day your journey will end. You, too, will be home.

Are you on the road to Heaven? It is important to know! A test question is simply, "Where were you when you got on the road? Where were you when you trusted the Lord Jesus Christ as your Savior?" How important is it to know? Read Jesus's "Depart from Me, I never knew you" teaching in **Matthew 7:21-23**). If you do not know where you were, right where you are now, TRUST HIM. He is calling.

could not find a word to translate the words so integral to understand how to come to Christ believe or faith. On a very hot day a native teacher climbed the steps into his office and sat down in a chair using a native word that meant "I'm resting my whole weight on this chair." Immediately Paton had found his word for faith. You see to come to Christ for salvation, one has to believe the Gospel to the point that he puts his faith and trust in the Lord Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. Scriptures that explain this are **John** 3:16, Ephesians 2:8-9, and Romans 10:8-13. Around the world in myriad cultures, I have taught how to come to Christ with the help of a chair. My students ask a question: "Teacher, do you believe that chair will hold you up?" Then I check the chair out to see how substantial it is. Then I say, "Yes, I believe that chair will up me up." This is simply intellectual belief. But when I sit down in it, it demonstrates the act of exercising faith by trusting the chair. It is not enough merely to believe the Gospel story of the Father sending His Son, who died for our sins on the cross of Calvary, one must trust. That is an internal matter of the "heart" (not your blood pump, but the part of you where you think, love, and make decisions the mind. You call on Jesus to save you. You trust Him. Then with your mouth you tell others what you have done.

THE ISSUE: WHERE WERE YOU WHEN YOU TRUSTED CHRIST AS YOUR SAVIOR IN ACCORDANCE TO THESE SCRIPTURES? IF YOU DO NOT KNOW, ASK THE LORD JESUS TO SAVE YOU AND TRUST HIM. YOU MIGHT BE WALKING DOWN THE ROAD, SITTING IN YOUR LIVING ROOM OR AT THE KITCHEN TABLE, OR LYING ON YOUR BED. One person recently shared that he was sitting on the front porch of his neighbor's home. A man in South Africa said that he was in a funeral car going to the burial site of his brother. A man in Grand Rapids, Michigan, said that he trusted Christ in his prison cell. A lady said she trusted Christ in the hospital. An elderly lady in South Korea said that she came to Christ for salvation in a Japanese concentration camp. Remember salvation is near your even in your heart and mouth, that is, the word of faith which we preach.



The Word is near you, even in your heart and your mouth, that is THE WORD OF FAITH which we preach. If you believe in your heart that God raised Jesus from the dead and confess with your mouth that Jesus Christ is Lord and call upon Him to save you, you will be saved.

The matter of salvation

The Holy Scriptures are spoken of as being continually able to make men wise for salvation (See 2 Timothy 3:13). This means, first of all, that men learn the way of salvation through the Bible. It might also carry the thought that assurance of salvation comes through the Word of God.

Salvation is through faith which is in Christ Jesus. We should mark this well. It is not through good works, baptism, church membership, confirmation, keeping the Golden Rule, or in any other way that involves human effort or merit. Salvation is through faith in the Son of God.

The consistent teaching of the Scriptures is that salvation is by grace, not of works, and that the true believer is eternally secure (John 3:16; 5:24; 10:27-29).
