God is My Keeper

HAVE YOU EVER noted how often in the Bible God promises to "keep" His own? Here are a few of them. "And behold, I am with you and will keep you in all places you may go" (Genesis 28:15); "He will keep your foot from being taken [caught in a trap]" (Proverbs 3:25-26). "Lest any hurt you, He will keep you day and night (Isaiah 27:3). He will keep you as a shepherd does his flock" (Ezekiel 34:1). He will keep you from the evil that is in the world (Psalm 127:7). He will keep you from falling (Jude 34). He will keep you from the hour of temptation (Revelation 3:10). See, I am sending an angel before you to keep you on the way and to be your guide into the place I have made ready for you (Exodus 23:20). "I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep what I have committed to Him until that day" (2 Timothy 1:12b).

<u>CAREFULLY CONSIDER! TRANSFORM</u> <u>YOUR THOUGHTS!</u>

Through God's providence upon our relocation from Murfreesboro, Tennessee to Lynchburg, Virginia, in April 2002, He gave us two outstanding Sunday school teachers. From July 2002 through September 2016, we sat under the teaching of Dr. Gaylen Leverett, a professor at Liberty University, at Forest Baptist Church for fourteen years. Actually his class, which sometimes numbered over eighty, was "a church within the church" that emitted a warm, sweet fellowship that embraced his learners. Due to our need to have a closer church home, Ed and Jean Bradshaw, longstanding Doorkeepers. urged us to consider nearby Beulah Baptist Church, about five minutes away from our home. We became members the first Sunday in October 2016. Ed took us to their Sunday class that was taught by Bill Hogan who is now ninety-three years old. In academia, his style of teaching would be labeled "lecturing." He carefully prepares, writing out his remarks (often citing Hershael Hobbs, one of my favorites) and delivering them to his class. Ed had explained Bill's teaching style to Sue and me so we go with Bible in hand prepared to listen, review Scripture mentally, and draw strength for our spiritual journey.

Early in a recent lesson from Romans 12:9-21, Bill asked that we focus on the word "Transform" linking it with how anyone could fulfill the expected behavior of a Christian listed in Paul's exhortation. As usual, he laid out Paul's litany of commands to those early Roman believers. I encourage you to take time to read what

<u>is expected of you as a Christian</u>.

Our brother was right on target in pairing "... <u>be</u> <u>transformed by the renewing of your mind</u>.." (v 2) with his scriptures for the lesson (vv 9-21). In the <u>Prayer Seminar Workbook</u>, we deal with 1 <u>Thessalonians 5:23</u> detailing how God has made us, viz, a trichotomy (spirit, soul, body). The "soul" is termed "person" in a study of psychology and includes mind, emotion, and will. The mind, emotions, will and body are not born again. It is helpful to focus on the mind; whatever is in our minds, determines our behavior. <u>The transformation Paul is talking about has to do with our thoughts</u>.

The secret for successful Christian living is "hiding" the Word of God in our mind. The Holy Spirit came to live in you the moment you trusted Jesus as your Savior, when your name was written in the Book of Life with the indelible blood of Jesus and when the Holy Spirit baptized (placed you) into the body of Christ. At that time the transaction was sealed by the Holy Spirit as you stepped through the gate to travel on the road to Heaven.

Remember, <u>our mind, emotions, will ("soul," "person") and body are not born again</u>. It was a spiritual birth in your human spirit that afforded you new life. It was at that very moment that a struggle began in your mind. Satan's desire from that time is to pollute your mind and for most Christians he has succeeded without much resistance.

Paul deals with his personal struggle in Romans 7. As you read and ponder his account, keep reading. "Thank God, there is victory in the Lord Jesus Christ." In Romans 12:2, he goes into detail on how to realize that victory.

TRANSFORM. The Greek word, metamorphoo, means "to change form," as does the English derivative metamorphosis. In the New Testament, this word is used to describe the inward renewal of our mind through which our inner spirit is changed into the likeness of Christ. Paul told the Roman believers: "Be transformed by the renewing of your minds." As our Christian life progresses we should gradually notice that our thought life is being changed from Christlessness to Christlikeness. Transformation does not happen overnight, but our transportation is continuous. We are conformed to Christ's image gradually as we spend time in the Word and in intimate fellowship with Him (2 Corinthians 3:18).

It is reported that an African lady had a book in her hand. Someone asked her what she was reading. Her response was, "The Bible. but I am not reading it. It is reading me." I remember the Sunday afternoon in September 1984 when I was preparing copy for a Reflector. I was reviewing notes from Dr. Earl Radmacher who delivered the Staley Lectures during my tenure at Northeastern Bible College. As <u>I focused on his comments</u> about the importance of the thought life, along with some comments shared by Dr. Craig Lampe about the importance of having your family in a Bible-believing, Biblepracticing church, I was deeply convicted and tears began to fall and a conversation with my Heavenly Father began that was transforming in my life and ministry. I turned to a copy of the 79-page Prayer Seminar Workbook to the section that deals with the mind and earnestly confessed my own failure and asked that I might implement in my personal life what I was teaching.

Thank you, Bill Hogan, for being the catalyst to bring back to my memory the importance of my thought life, a truth that is as valid today as when the Holy Spirit dealt with me on this matter thirty-eight years ago in our home at the corner of Floyd Drive/ Arrow Court in Murfreesboro, Tennessee as I was writing an article for the November 1984 Reflector. It is with freshness and excitement that I begin each day with God examining my thought life and making needed adjustments for a new day of life. Join me in the journey.
